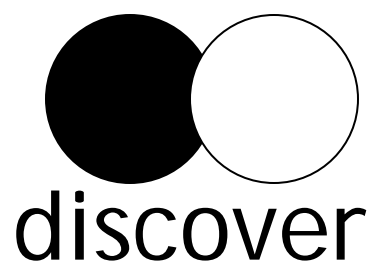
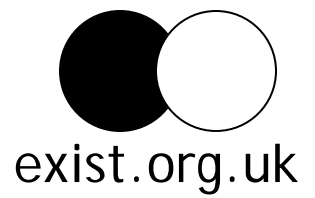


prog 6: what if i can talk to God?

when you pray; say: give us today our daily bread

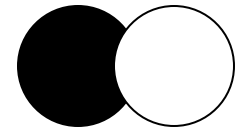


request.

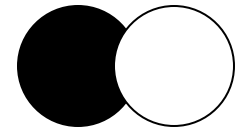
we live in the 'now'

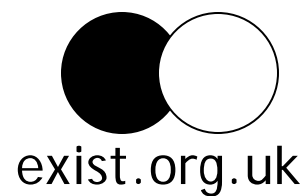
